Printing technique

Digital printing: this printing process uses HP Indigo technology, and sits halfway between offset and digital printing. It is ideal for commercial or industrial uses that require long print runs and high-quality printing, producing prints with bright colours and a high resolution.



Digital printing

Cutting method

Laser cutting is used for all roll labels. The roll labels have minimum dimensions of 1 x 1 cm and maximum dimensions of 30 x 30 cm.

Kiss cut with backing left on: the adhesive material is trimmed to the required size and shape, with the backing left in place and the swarf (excess material) removed.

Die cutting

Standard die cut: laser die cutting that offers complete freedom for custom sizes, with a choice of standard shapes (circle, square or rectangle) and no limits on print runs. A cut line is not required in the print file.

Custom shape: laser die cutting that offers complete freedom for custom shapes and sizes and no limits on print runs. A cut line must be provided in the print file.

White printing

Selective white: selective white is applied to specific areas of the material, and can be used on its own or as a base for printing. When used with printed designs, the layer of white ink will bring out the images and artwork, ensuring the colour of the material does not alter the design or make it appear dull.

Solid white: solid white is applied to the entire printing surface. It can be used on its own or as a base for printing. When used with printed designs, the layer of white ink will bring out the images and artwork, ensuring the colour of the material does not alter the design or make it appear dull.

A scratch-resistant protective gloss coating can be applied to the label to protect it from scratches and UV light.

Mirrored printing

This is the ideal printing method for labels that are to be applied to the inside of glass surfaces, to be visible from the outside. It is available for Deluxe Transparent Polypropylene and Transparent Refix Electrostatic Film.

Number of rolls

You can choose to receive one single roll (33 cm high) or to divide it into multiple rolls of various heights: into two (16.5 cm high), three (11 cm high) or six (5.5 cm high) rolls. Each cardboard reel has an internal diameter of 7.6 cm.

The distance between labels can be chosen when ordering: for polypropylene labels the minimum gap is 0.4 cm, while for paper labels it is 0.8 cm.

Deluxe Transparent Polypropylene

Glossy transparent polypropylene with a permanent, highly transparent acrylic adhesive, suitable for use outdoors. It can be ordered with mirrored printing, useful if the sticker is designed to be visible from the outside of a glass window.



Black Pulp-Dyed Paper

A high-quality, pulp-dyed, black self-adhesive paper. It sticks well to damp surfaces, even at low temperatures, and is highly resistant to immersion in water and ice. It is ideal for applying to dark containers or dark glass, for stylish products and a sophisticated way of getting your message across.

Die-Cut Stickers: stickers cut fully in your chosen standard or bespoke size and shape.

Kiss-Cut Stickers: stickers on rectangular or square backing, kiss cut in your chosen standard or bespoke size and shape. The swarf (excess sticker material) is not removed from the backing, and the entire surface is printed (both sticker and swarf).

Sticker Sheets: available in three different sizes, they allow you to combine multiple stickers of different shapes and sizes on the same sheet.

Finishes

To protect your stickers and make them last longer, you can choose from a range of protective coatings and lamination options, which are also recommended if you want to give the product a unique finish or sophisticated appearance.

Scratch-resistant varnish: Labellife3 scratch-resistant varnish with a gloss finish that protects stickers from scratches and UV light.

Gloss lamination: transparent protective film with a gloss finish that increases the stickers' strength and durability.




